ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 25.03.2025)

- 1. Ms. Pallavi Saigal, Counsel, appearing on behalf of the Petitioner, M/s POWERGRID Rampur Sambhal Transmission Limited (PRSTL) submitted that the pleadings in the matter are completed, and the matter may be listed for arguments.
- 2. During the hearing, the Commission observed that the matter is adjudicatory in nature, being filed under Section 86(1)(f) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and therefore, it is mandatory to have presence of Member (Law) in the quorum. In this regard, Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its judgement dated 12.04.2018 in Civil Appeal No. 14697 of 2015, has concluded that in any adjudicatory issue covered under Section 86(1)(f), it is mandatory that there should be a person of law as a Member of the Commission.
- 3. In view of above, and owing to vacancy in the position of Member (Law), the Commission directs to keep the matter in abeyance and list the matter subsequent to appointment of the Member (Law).
