

ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 12.11.2024)

1. During the hearing, Ms. Ritika Singhal, counsel for Petitioner, sought additional two weeks' time to submit their rejoinder to the UPPCL's reply dated 08.10.2024. Subsequently, Ms. Singhal, requested the Commission to permit the Petitioner to file an IA to bring on record new invoices towards transportation charges of ash issued by the contractors after submission of the instant petition.
2. The Commission accepted the Petitioner's request and allowed two weeks' time to file an IA. The Commission allowed UPPCL to file its reply within four weeks and thereafter four weeks for the Petitioner to file its consolidated rejoinder.
