1. The Petitioner is a private limited company primarily engaged in the business of developing and managing Data centres, infrastructure facilities and other allied business activities including the distribution of electricity within the Data centre. The Commission vide its Order dated 19.06.2023 issued the Distribution License to the Petitioner for carrying out the business of distribution of electricity in the area of Data Centre Park situated at Plot No. 7, Knowledge Park – V, Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh subject to conditions as stipulated in the License. Further, the Commission



vide Order dated 9 February 2024 in Petition No. 2052 of 2023, had approved the Ceiling Tariff of HV1 category & LMV-9 category as contained in the Tariff Order of NPCL dated 24th May 2023, which would be applicable until the issuance of the Tariff Order of NIDP. In the said Petition, the Petitioner had submitted that it shall be in a position to file the Petition for approval of ARR and tariff based on the actual data after 6-8 months. i.e. in the month of November 2024.

2. The Commission vide its letter dated 13th November, 2024 had directed all the licensees covered by UPERC (Multi Year Tariff for Distribution and Transmission) Regulations, 2019 Second Amendment) Regulation, 2019, including the Petitioner, to file the Tariff Petition for True-Up for FY 2023-24, APR for FY 2024-25 and ARR/Tariff for FY 2025-26 by 30th November, 2024.
3. The Petitioner has filled the present Petition seeking extension of time for filling Business Plan and MYT Petition under the UPERC (Multi Year Tariff for Distribution and Transmission) Regulations, 2019 and its amendments.
4. Further, an application dated 03rd January, 2025 has been received from the petitioner, seeking adjournment in the matter as the representative of the Petitioner, who had to appear on its behalf, was not available to appear on the date of hearing due to personal exigency.
5. The Commission accepts the request for adjournment made by the Petitioner.
6. The next hearing in the matter is scheduled on 11th February 2025.
